APT TO BE raced off the rail near the middle of the field and was along in the final furlong. AJEDREZ (ARG) raced close up off the rail and took the lead on the turn but could not hold off the winner. FIERY DIABLO raced close up off the rail and lacked a winning bid. MUD SHARK lacked speed and improved his position. SULTAN OF SPIN raced near the middle of the field and weakened. PERSUAGGLE set the pace from the inside and tired. COWBOY CODE lacked speed and was not a factor. MARION'S MAN raced near the middle of the field and gave way.
