INCA KING was away alertly to set the pace, was collared after a half, contested the issue off of the inside through the second turn, was suddenly clear when I BELIEVE IN ME dropped out entering the stretch and held safely thereafter. DIVINE MASTER attended the pace between horses, shifted out with a furlong to run and was making up ground late. GENERAL CHARLEY stalked the pace three deep, loomed a threat entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. T. C. CHAMP settled in the second flight, swung five wide to make a late rally and improved his position. SOLO CAT angled in and was forwardly placed along the hedge, got through entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. ROCKET LEGS was hustled along three wide while never far back, came four wide to make a mild bid but lacked a response when called upon. TIGER WOODMAN was hustled along in mid pack on the inside, finished with a mild rally but failed to threaten. OLD MAN BUCK was pinched back at the start and failed to respond thereafter. SHORE DO saved ground to no avail. I BELIEVE IN ME pressed the pace three wide, drew even after a half, disputed the issue to the stretch, faltered and faded fast. Following the race I BELIEVE IN ME was unsaddled on the backstretch and vanned off. LABOR UNION was outrun. NINTH CLIENT was hustled along on the inside for a half and dropped out.
