CLAUDIA'S FORUM was angled inside on the first turn and got good position, saved ground on the turn then slipped through in upper stretch, gained command in late stretch then was all out to hold sway in the end. SCRAPPY ROO was settled while racing two wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then moved out to be four wide and closed fast in the stretch to be gaining but was too late. CLUB TEJANO was allowed to settle then was five wide on the backstretch, swung out to be eight wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in late stretch to finish fast. WAJIR ON ME was unhurried early then was settled on the run down the backstretch, stayed on the inside and was flying late along the inside to be gaining ground. VALID MESSAGE was unhurried early and started making a run heading into the far turn, swung out to be nine wide in upper stretch and was gaining ground in late stretch but was no menace. ONLY MAN IN TOWN raced five wide on the first turn then was settled on the run down the backstretch, moved up strongly three wide on the far turn making the lead in mid stretch but came up empty in the end. FAVORITE JAZZ was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, was gaining ground while five wide in the stretch but was no threat. GENERAL CHARLEY set a well handled pace from the start, was in a long drive on the far turn then weakened in late stretch. FILET GUMBO was on the inside and saving ground on the far turn then failed to menace in the stretch drive. BULLET CRANE was unhurried early then raced two wide on the far turn and failed to respond in the stretch when asked. KITE SEEKER was unhurried early then made five wide rally on the far turn but flattened out in the stretch. THEATRICAL'S HALO was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, made a bid then flattened out in the stretch drive. RARE FLYER was unhurried early then was five wide heading into the far turn, was steadied when in tight in the middle of the far turn and stopped in the stretch. BOOM BOOM BUBBA pressed the early pace while racing two wide, was hard used then gave way on the far turn.
