Footnotes

GENERAL CHARLEY went readily to the lead, dictated the pace along the inside to the far turn, held sway on a clear margin to upper stretch and was kept to pressure to maintain his advantage. FAITH'S MAGIC tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, worked his way to the inside approaching the far turn, came inside a rival to challenge the leader in upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with that foe but proved second best. SPIDER POWER (IRE) was settled along the inside in the opening half, shifted off the inside on the far turn to split foes, switched back to the rail entering upper stretch and produced his best stride to finish willingly for a share. GARBURETOR, bumped by POLTERGEIST at the start, was settled in the opening half, made steady progress to split foes three wide racing into upper stretch but had no final bid. SNAKE RIVER CANYON stalked just outside the pacesetter from the outset, couldn't gain terms with that foe after six furlongs and steadily faded leaving the far turn. SWORD AND SHIELD, reserved in hand in early stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. ECONOMIC BAILOUT worked his way to the inside tracking just off the leaders in the opening stages, made a brief bid along the inside leaving the far turn but emptied out in upper stretch. RICHLAND CREEK tracked the pace between foes three deep in second flight racing to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. OPTIMER (ARG) was settled along the inside in the opening half, swung eight deep entering upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. HARBOR WIN urged to contention racing four wide into the first turn, made a

brief bid in that path racing through the far turn, drifted out nearing upper stretch and quickly gave way. POLTERGEIST broke in bumping a rival, was caught four wide racing as part of the second flight to the backstretch, steadily faded from striking distance on the far turn. OUGHTA BE MINE dropped out of contention early.
