

General gets 4th win

General Charley, owned by the Red Rabbit Racing stable, joined two other horses who have won four races at the Arlington Park meet. The 8-year-old gelding, sent off the even-money favorite in Saturday's fifth race, went wire to wire under jockey Eddie Perez and won by 3½ lengths. As usual, the winner's circle was filled with more than 50 people supporting the Red Rabbit stable, headed by Arlington Heights resident Rick Johnson. It was the eighth win for General Charley since he joined the stable of trainer Chris Block and the Red Rabbit owners in 2008.
