Footnotes

GANDOLPH FINCH gained a clear lead soon after the start, increased his margin, then lasted. TIGER BUD mid pack and inside, gained position through the second turn, got through inside of rivals into the stretch, then made a steady gain and hung. GUIDING MISSILE stalked the early pace outside, moved up through the second turn, drifted out slightly while bidding into the stretch, then could not gain the final furlong. REY DEL SOL mid pack and outside, looped rivals four wide through the second turn, bid five wide into the stretch and came up empty. IT'S ABOUT IMAGE stalked the early pace inside, then lacked a stretch rally. BONNISTAR showed little. CONSTABULARY was no factor. GENERAL CHARLEY was never involved.
