CHEROKEE LORD gained a position stalking the first flight a bit off the inside racing into the backstretch, continued under light reserve to the second bend, steadily moved to terms with the leaders three deep racing into upper stretch, then narrowly prevailed in the closing stages under firm handling to just edge TAZZ under pressure. The latter angled inwards maintaining terms with the pacesetter attending that foe's under firm rating in to the opening stages, moved to press the issue between foes racing into upper stretch and grudgingly contested the issue inside the winner to the end. WORKIN FOR HOPS was rated along the inside tracking the first flight from just out of striking distance, saved ground through the second bend steadily gaining striking distance, altered course avoiding close quarters entering upper stretch to challenge four deep nearing the furlong marker and continued willingly in that path to close the gap while earning a share. SUNTRACER settled outside a rival from out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention while being fanned five wide racing through the stretch and continued to make mild progress in that path to the end. FORBIDDEN FOREST settled inside a rival from out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half, drew into contention racing into upper stretch while shifting off the inside, split foes nearing midstretch but finished evenly in the last furlong. MR. MISCHIEF sped to the fore while angling to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the rail to the second bend, briefly disputed the issue inside foes into upper stretch but gave out leaving the furlong marker.
