KEEP UP, reserved in last along the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention leaving the far turn while shifting off the inside, split foes nearing upper stretch then angled out five wide and produced a steady late response to prevail in time under firm right handed pressure. CORPORATE JUNGLE angled inwards in the opening stages while being rated just off the first flight, continued under light reserve into the second bend, was urged to advance while shifting out four wide racing into upper stretch but couldn't match the winner. WORKIN FOR HOPS, forwardly placed attending a rival's pace while nearest the rail racing into the backstretch, moved to press the issue racing into upper stretch but yielded to the top pair in late stages. FRANCOIS angled inwards to track off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, continued under some reserve to the second bend, then split foes just off the inside in late stages while making an effort to improve position. TURALLURE, caught outside foes racing into the first turn, made an early move to striking distance three deep before a half, pressed the issue in that path racing into the second bend and quickly came up empty. CHEROKEE LORD moved to the fore outside a rival racing to the first turn prompting the pace, pressed the issue between foes into the far turn and gave way racing into upper stretch. SAMMY ALEXANDER (GB), reserved along the inside in the opening stages while racing in some close quarters early, shifted out four wide racing into the far turn while being prompted to advance but had no closing bid.
