#4 HATTAASH (E) (Closer) Son of Strong Hope is out of a stakes winning half sister to the dam of Rachel Alexandra and earned top ranking on BRIS Speed Last Race and Late Pace Last Race when winning over nine furlongs here three weeks ago. Six-year-old now has a record of 12-2-3-4 on the Arlington Polytrack and gelding, who appears to be still improving, should find enough early pace here to make his late run style effective with Kent Desormeaux retaining the mount.

#6 P D Q KIDDO (E) (Stalker) Eight-year-old is first on BRIS Back Speed and was disappointing when unplaced behind the top selection in his latest but may have still needed that race being just his second of the year. Son of Silic is trained by Roger Brueggemann who wins with 27% of his runners third time off a layoff and with 20% overall in allowance races and gelding can be stalking the early leaders with Florent Geroux riding.

#3 SHARED PROPERTY (E) (Closer) Son of Scat Daddy won the Grade Three Arlington Washington Futurity as a juvenile in his one previous start on this track and in one of his two starts on a synthetic surface. Dark bay is first on BRIS Current Class and comes off a fifth place finish at Churchill in May for trainer Tom Amoss who wins with 22% of his runners switching from regular to synthetic dirt. Gelding can be running late with James Graham taking the ride.

#7 NATES MINESHAFT (D) (Speed) Six-year-old is first on BRIS Prime Power and Average Class Last 3 and comes off an unplaced effort in the Hanshin Stakes here after showing speed in his first outing since finishing a close third in the Grade One Stephen Foster Stakes last June. Son of Mineshaft clearly needed his last outing but has now failed to hit the board in two starts on synthetic surfaces and, while likely the pacesetter, may face pressure on the front end.

#2 WORKIN FOR HOPS (D) (Presser) Son of excellent synthetic surface sire City Zip comes off a third place finish in a tough stakes on the grass here early this month after being involved from the start and has a record of 5-2-1-1 on the Arlington main track.

Six-year-old is trained by Chris Block who wins with 23% of his runners switching from turf to an all-weather track and gelding can be in the early mix with Eddie Perez retaining the mount.

#5 FORBIDDEN FOREST (E) (Stalker) Five-year-old finished over six lengths behind the top selection when third over nine furlongs in his latest three weeks ago and now has a record of 6-1-3-2 on this Polytrack. Trainer Leo Gabriel wins with 14% of his allowance runners and has won with two of his eight starters this meet but gelding has to find something to reverse the placings with Hattaash.

#1 DIMENSION (E) (Closer) Son of Medicean won one of his four starts on artificial surfaces in England before arriving in North America where he has hit the board in one of his four starts on turf and was last seen when fifth at Indiana Downs in May over seven and a half furlongs. Dark bay is trained by Conor Murphy who has won with two of his twelve starters this year and five-year-old could improve with the surface switch with Eddie Castro riding.
