Footnotes

DANCING ROCK was rated just off the first flight along the inside tracking the leaders in the opening half, continued under patient handling saving ground to upper stretch, shifted out when presented an opening while being urged to advance on the pacesetter and wrested command from that foe in time under steady handling. GREEN SECRET was urged to secure the lead racing to the first turn while angling to the rail, set the pace on a narrow margin along the inside to the second bend, was urged to widen the margin racing into upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner late. DAKOTA DIGGER tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight in the opening half, shifted out to bid three wide racing into the stretch and continued willingly to late stages while edging a rival for a share. MAVERICKING, reserved off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, angled to the inside racing into the far turn, then saved ground through the final three furlongs while making an effort to improve position. BERGERAC, forwardly placed prompting the pacesetter in the opening half, was urged to press the issue on the far turn and gave way racing into upper stretch. WORKIN FOR HOPS tracked off the second flight early, shifted out three wide, then four wide racing through the far turn and had no late response.
